## Directions and parking

**Directions:** Unless you have a trailer and need to follow the main roads via Totnes, the best way to get to Salcombe from the A38 (coming from the direction of Exeter) is as follows.

Ignore the exit signposted to Totnes, Dartmouth, Kingsbridge and Salcombe (the route via Totnes can be painfully slow) and continue on the A38 until you see the exit signposted 'Plymouth Park and Ride' and 'Ermington, Modbury & Yealmpton'. At the end of the slip road, turn left. At the crossroads at the bottom of the hill, cross over, signposted 'Loddiswell'.

After approximately 2 miles, at California Cross, fork left just after the BP garage, signposted 'Loddiswell & Kingsbridge'. Go through Loddiswell, down the hill and across the valley. At the top of the next (long and windy) hill, turn right signposted 'Kingsbridge, Salcombe & Plymouth'. At the roundabout, take the second exit. Go through Churchstow and turn left at the roundabout. After a few miles, you'll come to a 'T' junction. Turn right, and follow the road through Malborough to Salcombe. (In Malborough, at the garage, there is a well-stocked Co-op in case you need emergency provisions!).

As you approach Salcombe, take the left turn immediately after the pedestrian crossing into Onslow Road. Go down the hill and Allenhayes Road is the fourth turning on the right, just before the road narrows and turns sharp left. Follow Allenhayes Road round to the left, and Albany House is the first house on the left after the trees.

**Parking:** The parking area to the left and front of the house is for all three flats so please park well off the road so as to allow room for others and, particularly, access to the space in front of the house. We don't allocate spaces to specific flats but, if you are staying in Flat 3, have two cars and can do so, please park close to the wall where the dustbins are, and park right up to the drain. This way you should be able to fit both cars onto the drive without inconveniencing those in Flats 1 and 2.
